

**OLYMPIA EARLY LEARNING CENTER
PAYMENT SCHEDULE
Effective January 1, 2010**

Registration Fee:

\$50.00 Per child enrolled

\$50.00 Per child enrolled due at yearly anniversary date

Full Rate: Full rate is charged to families with gross household income of over \$3000.00 per month.

Infants (4 weeks – 11 months) **\$775 per month** (25% discount for 2 or more children = **\$581.25**)

Toddlers (12 months – 29 months [2 _]) **\$680 per month** (25% discount for 2 or more children = **\$510**)

Preschool (2 _ - 5 years) **\$610 per month** (25% discount for 2 or more children = **\$457.50**)

SLIDING FEE SCALE

***Families qualify if they do not qualify for DSHS full time child care and if their gross income is \$3000 or less.**

Infants (4 weeks – 12 months) Multiply gross income by **25%**. **Lowest sliding fee for infants = \$465 per month**

Toddlers (12 months – 29 months) Multiply gross income by **21.83%**. **Lowest sliding fee for toddlers = \$408 per month**

Preschool (2 _ - 5 years) Multiply gross income by **19.5%**. **Lowest sliding fee for preschoolers = \$366 per month**

*Parents who enroll 2 or more children with our center receive a 25% discount for the older child.

**** Families must apply to Working Connections to determine eligibility. They will be charged based on the sliding fee scale through their first full month of child care to allow time for DSHS to process their application. If the parents fail to turn in their application, the fee will increase to full fee rate for the second month of service.**

**** Families NOT eligible for Working Connections may use the sliding fee scale with appropriate determination of their income.**

IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE SLIDING FEE RATE, PARENTS MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION OF *HOUSEHOLD INCOME:

- 1. Monthly paycheck stubs for the most current pay period and the past two months for each household member.**
- 2. Verification of child support received for child(ren) enrolling at OELC. If you are not receiving child support, please obtain a confirmation letter from the Office of Support Enforcement.**

NOTE: "Household" is defined as those adults who are in a committed relationship and share a household with their common or respective children. This includes:

- A. Unmarried parents living together with mutual child(ren)
- B. Unmarried parents living together with their mutual and non-mutual children if there is at least one mutual child
- C. Married individuals living together with children in the household
- D. A non-TANF minor parent living independently
